- 1-8 1s+2s circle 4H round to left, 1s dance in & cast to 3rd place
- 9-16 Is dance RH across (Lady with 3s & Man with 4s), pass RSh & dance LH across with other couple
- 17-24 1L+2M **also** 1M+5L turn RH, 1L+5M **also** 1M+2L turn LH (1s end 3rd place own side)
- 25-32 1s dance in & cast to 5th place, 5s+1s circle 4H round to right. 2 3 4 5 1

- 1-8 1s cross RH & cast to 2nd place, 1s dance ½ Fig of 8 round 2s
- 9-16 1s+3s dance RH across, LH back
- 17-24 1L followed by 3L dance Tandem reel of 3 across with 2s (1L ends 3rd pl) while 3M followed by 1M reel of 3 with 4s (3M to 2nd pl)
- 25-32 1s+4s dance ½ R&L, turn partners RH 1½ times

- 1-8 2s & 4s dance full diagonal RSh reels of 4 with 1st corners (passing partner LSh to start)
- 9-16 2s & 4s dance full reel of 4 with 2nd corners (dancing LSh round partner to face 2nd corners)
- 17-24 2s & 4s dance Figs of 8 on sides dancing in front of dancer on left (Ladies down & Men up) & meet ready for a Poussette
- 25-32 1s+2s **also** 3s+4s dance ½ Diamond Poussette, 1s+4s **also** 3s+5s dance ½ Diamond Poussette to end 2 4 1 5 3

- 1-8 1s cross RH & cast 1 place, dance RH across with 3s & end 1M+3L **also** 1L+3M in prom hold facing out to pass corner person RSh
- 9-24 All dance 4x ½ Reels of 3 on sides (to right to start, then left, right & left)
 - with 1s+3s changing partners in centre at end of each $\frac{1}{2}$ Reel to progress Men clockwise & Ladies anticlockwise.

End in centre 1s facing down & 3s facing up

25-32 $\,$ 1s dance between 3s turning 3s with nearer hand 1½ times,

crossing over to own sides & turn 4th person on own sides (Men RH & Ladies LH)

- 1-8 1s set advancing & turn 2H to face down & give nearer hand to 2s (2s face up), 1s+2s set & 1s turn 2s on sides with nearer hand
- 9-16 1s followed by 2s (who dance up to follow) dance down for 3 bars, 1s dance to top **as** 2s divide & follow, 1s cast to 2nd place & 2s to top & face out
- 17-24 2s+1s+3s dance reflection reels of 3 on sides (1s in & down to start, all joining hands where possible) 2s & 3s ending with a loop
- 25-32 1s dance ½ reels of 3 across (Lady with 2s & Man with 3s), 1s dance ½ reels of 3 across (Man with 2s & Lady with 3s)

- 1-8 1L & 3L cross down 1 place & cast up on opp side into centre **as** 1M & 3M dance across & cast down into centre, 1s+2s & 3s+4s dance RH across
- 9-16 1s & 3s dance reel of 4 up & down centre of dance
- 17-24 1s & 3s ¾ turn RH to face up **while** 2s & 4s dance up on sides & turn in to face down & all set, all circle 4H round to left & end on sides
- 25-32 1s & 3s lead up between 2s/4s crossing over & cast down 1 place,
 - 1s & 3s turn 2H & 1s lead down to 4^{th} place \mbox{as} 3s cast up on own sides to 2^{nd} place

- 1-8 1s cross RH & cast 1 place, 1s cross RH & cast 1 place (Man up Lady down)
- 9-16 1s dance ½ reels of 3 across (1M with 2s & 1L with 3s), set in lines across & change places RH with opposite person
- 17-24 2s+1s+3s chase clockwise ½ way,
 - 1s dance in & turn RH to face 1st corner positions as 2s & 3s continue to chase on to places (as bar 16)
- 25-32 1s dance ½ reel of 4 with 1st corners, passing RSh dance ½ reel with 2nd corners & cross passing RSh to 2nd place own sides

- 1-8 Ladies dance RSh round their corners, dance RH across ending in centre
- 9-16 Ladies dance LSh round their partners, dance LH across & back to places
- 17-24 Men dance RSh round their partners, dance RH across ending in centre
- 25-32 Men dance LSh round corners, dance LH across & back to places
- 33-40 1s & 3s turn partners RH 1¼ times, Men followed by partners dance out btwn side couples & back to places (1M thru 4s & 3M thru 2s)
- 41-48 1s+3s dance R&L
- 49-64 2s+4s repeat bars 33-48
- 65-72 Ladies dance in turning right about to dance out, cast clockwise to opposite Lady's place
- 73-80 Men dance in turning left about to dance out, cast anticlockwise to opposite places
- 81-88 All turn partners RH 1¼ times into prom hold, Promenade anticlockwise ½ way round to original places
