- 1-8 1s+2s dance R&I
- 9-16 1s cross RH, cast, turn 1½ RH to 2nd place own sides
- 17-24 1s dance Fig 8 round 3s

H.I.S.C.D. (R8x32) 3C (4C set)

25-32 2s+1s circle 4H round to Left. 1s+3s circle 4H round to Right

Devised at RSCDS AGM 2014 watching a man in canoe trying to paddle against the current on the Tay.

- 1s+2s dance the Tourbillon: tourbillon 1-8
 - 1s & 2s turn partners 2H ½ way, 1M & 2L lead partners on 1 place clockwise
 - (to end 1s on Ladies side & 2s on Men's side), 1s set to 2s
 - 1s & 2s ½ turn partners 2H, 1L & 2M lead partners on 1 place
 - (to end 2s in 1st place & 1s in 2nd place). 2s cross RH to own side while 1s pass RSh on bars 7+8 to face out.
- 9-16 2s+1s+3s reel of 3 on the sides (1M RSh to 2M, 1L RSh to 3L to start)
- 17-28 2s+1s+3s dances R&L for 3 couples
- 29-32 2s+1s circle 4H round to the Left

TRIP TO PERTH (R8x32) 3C set

Devised 2010 while on a trip to Perth for the AGM of the RSCDS

- 1-8 1s cross RH & cast 1 place, lead down LH, cross & cast up (2,1,3)
- 9-16 2s+1s+3s dance ½ Grand Chain (3s cross to start); all set and cross RH (3,1,2)
- 17-24 3s+1s Set&Link (1,3,2); all advance & retire Set and link (for 2 couples)
- 25-32 1s+3s+2s dance the Knot (2,3,1) knot for 3 couples

INTERVAL

Written as a strathspey, but it has been suggested we try it as a medley, twice in Strathspey time and twice in Reel time

BOATMAN, THE (\$4x32) **3s & 4s start on opposite sides** (2nd time through 1s & 2s are on opp sides)

- 9-16 2s & 3s dance Figs od 8 across, 2s crossing between 1s and 3s between 4s to start. Finish in original places.
- 17-24 1s+2s also 3s+4s dance ½ R&L, 1s+4s dance ½ R&L. (2)(4)1 3
- 25-32 All circle 8H round & back (2)(4)1 3

Note: For 1st & 3rd sequences dancers in third and fourth places are on opposite sides to start;

for 2nd & 4th sequences dancers in first and second places are on opposite sides to start

- 5L dances LH across with 2s while 5M dances RH across with 4s, 5s dance NHJ down through 3s & cast back to centre 17-24
- 25-32 5s turn (Kilt Grip) twice, 5s+1s set & dance part LH across (5s dance ½ way while 1s dance ¼ way & into centre to face 2s)

- 25-32 2s+3s+1s dance Grand Chain (2s crossing to commence)

- 9-16 1s dance ½ reels of 3 across (1M with 2s & 1L with 3s), set in lines across & change places RH with opposite person
- 17-24 2s+1s+3s chase clockwise ½ way,
 - 1s dance in & turn RH to face 1st corner positions as 2s & 3s continue to chase on to places (as bar 16)
- 25-32 1s dance ½ reel of 4 with 1st corners, passing RSh dance ½ reel with 2nd corners & cross passing RSh to 2nd place own sides
