- 17-24 1L followed by 1M dances behind 2L, up between 2s, behind 2M, across set to 2nd place own side (2s step up 23-24)
- 25-32 1s+3s dance RH across. 2s+1s dance LH across. 1L finishes facing out, ready to start again

- 17-24 2s+1s dance the Targe: - Targe Similar to the James Gray figure but NB Ladies turn in the centre twice
 - 17-18 1st & 2nd Ladies 34 turn RH while Men dance 14 way round anticlockwise
 - 19-20 1st Man with 2nd Lady & 1st Lady with 2nd Man full turn LH

 - `21-22 1st & 2nd Ladies 34 turn RH while Men dance 14 way round anticlockwise
 `23-24 1st Man with 2nd Lady & 1st Lady with 2nd Man turn 34 LH to end on sides to 2(1)3
