1- 8 1s set & cast 1 place, turn LH 1¼ times to end in Balance-in-Line position between 1st corners
9-16 1s+1st corners Balance-in-Line & turn corners RH to Balance-in-Line again with 1st corners
17-24 1s dance reel of 3 on sides (LSh to 2nd corner) & end diagonally between 2nd corners
25-32 1s+2nd corners Balance-in-Line & turn corners RH, Balance-in-Line again with 2nd corners
33-40 1s dance reels of 3 across (LSh to 3rd corners) & cross RH to 2nd places

1- 8 1s set, cast off. 1s set advancing, ½ turn partner RH and cast away to 2nd pl facing out
9-16 2s, 1s and 3s dance RSh reel of 3, finishing facing 1st corners
17-24 1s turn 1st corner BH, 1s turn 2nd corner BH, 1s dance ½ Fig of 8 (L up, M down)
25-32 2s, 1s and 3s dance the Knot [knot for 3 couples](#)

DONALD MACNEIL (H8x32) 3C (4C set)

1-8 1s NHJ dance down to 2nd place (2 bars) (2s step up) finishing back to back facing out
Double Triangles with 2s and 3s (6 bars) [Double Triangles](#)
9-16 1s dance ½ diagonal reel of 4 with 1st corners, and pass RSh
1s dance ½ diagonal reel of 4 with 2nd corners,
finishing with 1s in the middle taking LH and giving RH to 3rd corners (currently your 1st crnr person)
17-24 Balance in line (2nd corners also set)
1s turn half way while all corners dance on one place clockwise
Balance in line with 1st corner position, 1L with 2L, 1M with 3M (again all set)
1s turn ¾ into 2nd place while corners dance on one place clockwise.
25-32 All circle 6H round & back

1- 8 1s cross down to dance reflection reels of 3 on opposite sides with 1s & 3s
ending in centre facing down/up
9-16 1s+3s dance Ladies (RH) Chain [Ladies \(RH\) Chain](#)
ending with 1M facing Ladies side & 3M facing Men's side with partners behind them
17-24 1M **also** 3M (followed by partners & cast to start) dance a Fig of 8 round standing 2s passing firstly LSh in middle & then RSh
to end 1s still on opp sides
25-32 1s+2s+3s circle 6H round & back (1s finish still on opp sides)
33-40 1s+2s set & dance ¾ double Fig of 8 (1s cast to start) with 1s ending in 2nd place

1- 8 1s set & cast 1 place, 1s followed by 3s dance up & cast - 1s to 3rd place & 3s to 2nd place
9-16 1s cross down & dance reflection reels of 3 with 4s+5s on opposite sides - 1s end in 3rd place opposite sides
17-24 1s cross up & dance reflection reels of 3 on own sides with 2s+3s - 1s ending in 3rd place own sides
25-32 1s set & cast down 1 place, 1s followed by 5s dance up between 4s & cast - 1s to 5th place & 5s to 4th place

1- 8 1s+3s set. 1L dances down, casts up round 2M into middle facing down as 1M dances across, casts round 2L into middle facing up
while 3s dance same round 4s. 1s+3s change places RH with partner into line of 4 in middle (M face down, L face up)
9-16 1s+3s dance reel of 4 in middle
17-20 1s+2s also 3s+4s dance RH across
21-24 1M followed by 1L casts round 2L to 2nd place own sides as 3M followed by 3L casts round 4L to 4th place (2s+4s step up 23-24)
25-32 1s+4s (middle couples) dance Espagnole: [Espagnole](#)
25-26 1s+4s cross (Ladies lead across RH passing between Men) with Ladies changing places RH
27-28 1s+4s cross back (Men lead across RH between Ladies) with Men changing places RH
29-32 4s turn RH as 1s turn LH

ZOOLOGIST, THE (J8x32) 3C (4C set)

1- 8 1s cross down between 2s+3s & cast to right to face 2L/3M, dance ½ LSh reel of 3 across (1L with 2s, 1M with 3s)
& end facing 1st corner (pstn)
9-16 1s dance ½ diagonal reel of 4 & pass RSh to face 2nd corner (pstn), 1s dance ½ diagonal reel
& end in double triangle positions (facing opp sides)
17-24 1s dance Double Triangles [Double Triangles](#)
& end in middle facing opposite sides RSh to RSh
25-32 1s dance LH across (M with 3s at top & L with 2s),
Snake Pass (Z shape):
1M followed by 3M+3L **also** 1L followed by 2L+2M pass RSh diagonally across to change ends & loop round to right
to end on own sides. 2 1 3

1s cast up behind 2s & cross down to 2nd place own side17-24 2s+1s+3s dance Grand Chain
25-32 2s+1s+3s circle 6H round & back*Forthcoming dance programmes**Please ask the convener or instructor if you wish to practice any of the below dances (or any others) at future classes*
