- 1-8 1s+2s dance RH across, 1s+2s change places RH on sides & 1s+3s change places LH on sides
9-16 2s+3s+1s dance reel of 3 on own sides (3s+1s pass LSh to start)
17-24 3s+1s dance LH across, 1s & 3s change places LH on sides & 2s+1s+3s all set
25-32 2s+1s+3s circle 6H round to left for 3 bars & pivot left, all circle 6H round to the right to places

- 1-8 1M+2M ½ turn LH **while** 1L+2L ½ turn RH **while** 3s set, 3M pulling back LSh, 3L RSh, to face out [2 bars]
2s (facing out)+1s (facing in)+3s (facing out) Balance in Line [2 bars]
1s+3s change places (Men RH, Ladies LH) [2 bars]
2s+3s+1s Balance in Line [2 bars]
9-16 2s+3s+1s dance mirror reels of 3 on sides (2s out/down, 3s in/up, 1s out/up)
17-24 1s & 3s continue reel to change places (1s cast up to 2nd place **while** 3s dance down to 3rd place), 1s cross up LH between 2s cast to 2nd place opp sides, turn LH to face 1st corners
25-32 1s set to 1st corner, set to partner, set to 2nd corner, pull back RSh & dance round each other RSh to 2nd pl own side facing out.

- 1-8 1s & 4s set & cross RH (4 bars), cast in 1 place (bars 5+6) & dance LH across ½ way (bars 7+8)
9-16 All dance RSh reels of 4 on sides & end facing up/down
17-24 All set to facing person on sides & turn 2H, 2s+4s **also** 1s+3s circle 4H round to left
25-32 2s+4s **also** 1s+3s dance Diamond Poussette

5 couple square set, 5s in centre facing, 5M back to 4s, 5L back to 2s

- 1-8 1s+2s+3s+4s circle 8H round & back while 5s turn RH once & LH 1½ times to end 5M facing 2s & 5L facing 4s
9-16 5M+2s also 5L+4s dance RH across, 5s pass LSh & dance LH across with next couple anticlockwise (M with 1s & L with 3s)
17-24 5M dances reel of 3 with 1s+2s (in prom hold) giving RSh to 2s while 5L reels with 3s+4s giving RSh to 4s
25-32 All take partners in prom hold, 5s change pl with 1s RSh, 1s pass 4s RSh, 4s pass 3s RSh, 3s pass 2s RSh & 2s end in centre facing each other

- 1-8 1s lead down the middle and back to finish facing 2L, 1M behind his partner
9-16 1L followed by partner dance a full RSh Alternating Tandem reel of 3 across with 2s.
1s finish in middle facing up, 2s face down in 1st place
17-24 1s dance 3H across on sides (Ladies RH and Men LH), 1s dance up to top and cast to 2nd place
25-32 2s+1s+3s dance 6H round and back

- 1-8 1s dance down (2 bars) & turn 2H (2 bars), 1s dance up & cast to 2nd place
9-16 2s+1s+3s Set+Link for 3, 1s dance ½ Diag R&L starting Diagonally left
17-24 All Set+Link for 3, 1s dance ½ Diag R&L starting Diagonally left. (3)(1)(2)
25-32 All set & ½ turn RH, face partner and pull back RSh, dance out to places & set. 3 1 2

- 1-8 1s set cross RH, cast & turn ¾ RH to face opp sides (2s step up 5-6)
9-16 1M+2s also 1L+3s dance LH across, 1s pass LSh to dance RH across with other couple.
1s end BtoB in middle facing 1st corners
17-24 1s dance 'Hello-Goodbye' setting (6 bars), clap & petronella turn to 2nd place own side
25-32 2s+1s+3s circle 6H round & back
